### OUTCOMES



#### Developmental Milestones

Your Keyworker will assist your child to work towards important milestones and develop relevant skills.



#### Achievable Goals

Your Keyworker will work collaboratively with you to set realistic, achievable goals that reflect the needs of your child and your family.



#### Transition to Formal Education

Your Keyworker will support you and your child with transition to day care and kinder, as well as a strong focus on school readiness.



#### Parent Confidence and Capacity

Your Keyworker will support you to extend your understanding of your child's needs and provide you with the strategies and supports to confidently manage daily challenges.

A keyworker has specialist training and experience with children under the age of 7 years. They may be a speech therapist, an occupational therapist, or a specialist teacher.

Your keyworker may consult with other therapists to provide you and your child with the highest level of intervention and support across all therapy disciplines and to ensure you and your child are achieving their goals.

Your keyworker will be the person you will see and talk to the most. They will get to know you, your child and your family and tailor supports to achieve your child's goals.

Your keyworker will work closely with you and those important to your child, including educators and teachers, to develop and strengthen your child's skills and development so that they are able to engage in day to day life.

Your keyworker will provide supports at home, at kinder, at school and at the park or other community locations.
